2. You are hereby permitted to submit the compiled data/information/document, relating to your proposal for recognition of Electrohomeopathy, till June 30, 2022. It may be ensured that the combined material contains what IDC had asked for during the last meeting, held on 11.01.2021.

3. '22' 'hard copies' of the combined material may be submitted in a presentable format, and in a properly bound form, along with corresponding 'soft copy', preferably in a pendrive. In case the soft copy is submitted through e-mail, it should be so designed that it can be further e-mailed to all concerned smoothly and without any difficulty.

4. **The combined material submitted after 30/06/2022 may not be entertained.**

Lastly, in order to facilitate a meaningful discussion on the issue - which is going to be held any time during the **month of July, 2022** (*to be intimated in due course*) - it is reiterated that while finalising the combined material on the subject, **the joint body must keep in view IDC's broad advice** in the last meeting that they should work together, taking along all in the trade in the country, so that they could compile common solid and valid data/documents for submission to the Inter-Departmental Committee for its further review.
